

The penetration of Arabic culture in Venice is attested in the many Arabic imports in the Venetian dialect.

- **'Arsenal'** Venetian 'arsenal' Arabic *dār al-ṣināʿah* ((دار الصناعة, 'house of manufacture, factory' **'Artichoke'** – Venetian 'articioco' – Arabic *al-kharshū*f (الخرشوف)
- **'Marzipan'** Venetian 'marzapan' Arabic *mawthabān* (موثبان), the porcelain container in which marzipan was transported, or the city Mataban in the Bay of Bengal where it was produced **'Sequin'** Venetian 'zechin' Arabic *sikkah* (سك), meaning 'die'
