## Globes in the Collection

### ***Miniature Terrestrial Globe, by T. Harris & Son, London, c.1825 Inventory No. 33596***

This is an English terrestrial globe made in the first half of the 19<sup>th</sup>-century out of ivory and brass. It has lacquered paper gores printed from engraved plates which have been coloured by hand. It is inscribed, 'New Terrestrial Globe By T Harris & Son London' but not dated. It is probably made from gores printed between 1798 and 1820. It is 115 mm in height.
